- Participate in outreach & educational opportunities (planning events, tabling at info booths, preparing and giving talks to community organizations about the Archives)

There is room for more work at the Archives. If students have special skills and talents they feel would be of use, we would like to hear about them and can definitely find meaningful projects to start and/or complete.
